2. Thomas Jones School of Mission




Thomas Jones School of Mission formerly known as Cherra Theological College, established in the year 1887. This School of Mission

Nongsawlia Presbyterian Church was the first Church established in Meghalaya in the year 1846.


4. Nohkalikai falls
