Feedback Analysis

Overall feedback of 100 students was conducted, collected and analysed through questionnaires relating to their satisfaction towards the faculty, teaching-learning, evaluation and overall performance of the college. The following are the information derived from the survey.

1. Percentage of the syllabus covered in the class:
 - 39% of students responded as 85 to 100 %
 - 47% of students responded as 70 to 84 %
 - 8% of students responded as 55 to 69 %
 - 6% of students responded as 30 to 54 %

2. Preparation of the teachers for the classes:
 - 18% of students responded as thoroughly
 - 67% of students responded as satisfactorily
 - 7% of students responded as poorly
 - 8 % of students responded as indifferently

3. Effectiveness of teachers to communicate:
 - 28% of students responded as always effective
 - 48% of students responded as sometimes effective
 - 21% of students responded as just satisfactorily
 - 3% of students responded as generally ineffective
 - 0% of students responded as very poor communication

4. The teacher's approach to teaching:
 - 15% of students responded as excellent
 - 48% of students responded as very good
 - 27% of students responded as good
 - 7% of students responded as fair
 - 3% of students responded as poor

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers:
 - 25% of students responded as always fair
 - 67% of students responded as usually fair
 - 3% of students responded as sometimes unfair
 - 5% of students responded as usually unfair

6. Discussion of Students' performance in assignments:
 - 24% of students responded as every time
 - 51% of students responded as usually
 - 18% of students responded as occasionally/ Sometimes
 - 6% of students responded as rarely
 - 1 % of students responded as never discussed

7. The Teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications:
 - 36% of students responded as everytime
 - 39% of students responded as usually
 - 19% of students responded as occasionally/ sometimes
 - 6% of students responded as rarely

8. The teacher identify strengths of student and encouragement with providing right level of challenges:

- 26% of students responded as fully
- 48% of students responded as reasonably
- 14% of students responded as partially
- 12% of students responded as slightly

9. The teaching and mentoring process in the institution which facilitates the student in cognitive, social and emotional growth:

- 19 % of students responded as significantly
- 41 % of students responded as very well
- 31 % of students responded as moderately
- 8 % of students responded as marginally
- 1% of students not responded

10. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow:

- 10% of students strongly agree
- 58 % of students agree
- 25 % of students neither agree nor disagree
- 4 % of students disagree
- 3 % of students strongly disagree

11. The institute/teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences:

- 18 % of students strongly agree
- 49 % of students agree
- 24 % of students neither agree nor disagree
- 7 % of students disagree
- 2 % of students strongly disagree

12. Teacher inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

- 25 % of students strongly agree
- 35 % of students agree
- 29 % of students neither agree nor disagree
- 9 % of students disagree
- 2 % of students strongly disagree

13. Observation/suggestions to improve the overall teaching-learning experience in your institution.:

- 20% suggested to improve the infrastructure.
- 8% suggested to improve Library
- 17% Suggested to improve teaching Practice
- 13 % other suggestions
- 42 % not responded.



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
