 - 63 % of students strongly agree
 - 21 % of students agree
 - 4% of students neither agree nor disagree
 - 8 % of students disagree
 - 4% of students strongly disagree
- 3. Effectiveness of teachers to communicate:
 - 43% of students responded as always effective
 - 39% of students responded as sometimes effective
 - 13% of students responded as just satisfactorily
 - 3% of students responded as generally ineffective
 - 2% of students not responded

 - 24% of students responded as excellent
 - 31% of students responded as very good
 - 18% of students responded as good
 - 20% of students responded as fair
