 - 43 % of students strongly agree
 - 36 % of students agree
 - 12% of students neither agree nor disagree
 - 9 % of students not responded
- 2. The teachers prepare very well for the classes:
 - 53 % of students strongly agree
 - 28 % of students agree
 - 8% of students neither agree nor disagree
 - 6 % of students disagree
 - 5% of students strongly disagree
- 3. Effectiveness of teachers to communicate:
 - 48% of students responded as always effective
 - 35% of students responded as sometimes effective
 - 13% of students responded as just satisfactorily
 - 4% of students responded as generally ineffective
- 4. The teacher's approach to teaching:
 - 36% of students responded as excellent
 - 39% of students responded as very good
 - 18% of students responded as good
 - 2% of students responded as fair
 - 5% of students responded as poor
- 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers:
 - 46% of students responded as always fair
 - 25% of students responded as usually fair
 - 13% of students responded as sometimes unfair
 - 8% of students responded as usually unfair

 - 40% of students responded as usually
 - 21% of students responded as occasionally/ Sometimes
