### IX. CLASSES AND EXAMINATIONS IN 2020:

A. Regular Classes: Regular classes in the College were suspended from the 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020 on account of the nationwide lockdown announced by the Central Govt.

B. Online Classes: As per notification issued by the Meghalaya Education Department and by the university, North Eastern Hill University, all the educational institutions in the state of Meghalaya were asked to commence online classes tentatively from the month of May, 2020. However, on account of the remote location of the college, the region experiences frequent electrical and cellular outage, especially during the rainy season. On account of such shortcomings faced by the college, the conduct of online classes through platform like Zoom, Google meet and other such platform was highly difficult. Mobile apps like WhatsApp were frequently used by teachers and the college for sending notifications and sharing of study material. It must be noted, that on account of such difficulty, commencement of regular offline classes was highly desired by the teaching and student faculty. The difficulty in imparting lesson online due to electrical and internet shortcomings was overcome by the commencement of offline consultative classes in the month of September, 2021. The implementation of offline consultative classes was done as per government health protocols. C. Examinations: As per the decision of the University, Examinations for the 6<sup>th</sup> Semester were conducted in in the Online Blended Mode from the 23<sup>rd</sup> September - 16<sup>th</sup> October 2020. D. Partial Reopening for XI and XII: As per the decision of the State Govt, students of the College was partially reopened for students of classes XI and XII from the 15th of October. E. Full Reopening for Classes XI and XII: As per the order of the Education Department the College was fully reopened for classes XI and XII from the 30<sup>th</sup> of November 2020.
