

**REPORT ON ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON VERMICOMPOST IN
NONGTALANG COLLEGE, ORGANIZED BY SOCIOLOGY DEPARTMENT,
DATED 16th DECEMBER 2020**

A One Day Workshop on 'Vermi Compost', organized by Sociology Department, Nongtalang College, New Campus in which 84 students and teachers participated in the Training Programme.

The Programme started at 9:30 A.M. by the Welcome Address to the Resource Person, Shri. Steve Kurbah, Trainer in Agriculture, Rural Resource Training Centre (RRTC), Umran and Shri. Firstly Syiem, Field Assistant, by the Principal of the College and the Department concern

For the first session the students were taken to the new campus which is about 5 Kms from Nongtalang village at 10:00 A.M by the college bus.


The Workshop started by 10:30 A.M, and the Resource Person Shri. Steve Kurbah highlighted the importance of Vermi Compost in Agriculture and how it is helpful in employment generation and its benefit. It helps in preservation of soil and how it enhances its fertility by following this organic method in agriculture.

The Resource Person, Shri. Firstly Syiem (Field Assistant, RRTC, Umran) demonstrated the temporary construction of the shed with the help of the students participants in preparing the bamboos, straw, cowdung, dry leaves etc. showing the participants the different techniques how to prepare the Vermi Compost and the process of fermentation of the manure.

The Second Session started by 2:15 P.M in the Old Campus, in which the Resource Person demonstrated a slides show on various steps to be taken up after the decomposition of the vermin composting after the period of two months.
